## Certificate in PAC and Grassroots Management

Developed for advocacy professionals, this certificate program strengthens your understanding of two critical components of any political program: political action committees and grassroots advocacy.

You can choose to specialize in either PAC or grassroots management, but there is also the option to add a second specialization upon completion of the certificate.

Participants will earn 25 credits in the following areas:

 <b>PAC or grassroots specialization</b>	15 credits
 <b>Compliance management</b>	5 credits
 <b>Community engagement</b>	3 credits <i>(up to 7 credits)</i>

## Certificate in Public Affairs Management

Designed for current and rising leaders in public affairs, this certificate program will strengthen your knowledge of public affairs management and develop the skills to lead an integrated and strategic public affairs function.

Participants will earn 30 credits in the following areas:

 <b>Core public affairs management topics</b>	12 credits
 <b>Integration and leadership electives</b>	8 credits
 <b>Leadership in the public affairs community</b>	7 credits
 <b>Compliance management</b>	3 credits



To apply for the Certificate in Public Affairs Management program, individuals must have a minimum of seven years of experience.

## Certificate in Government Relations and Lobbying

Crafted for lobbyists or government relations professionals, this certificate program includes intensive training on the core components of working with policymakers and stakeholders. You'll enhance your understanding of the strategies needed to influence policy and rise as a leader in the field.

Participants will earn 25 credits in the following areas:

 <b>Core government relations and lobbying strategies</b>	16 credits
 <b>Leadership and engagement in the government relations community</b>	5 credits
 <b>Compliance management</b>	4 credits
