## **AXP PAC Contribution Criteria**

## PREVIOUS:

The AXP PAC supports candidates who share our views on important issues and who make policy decisions on issues that directly affect our businesses. Some of the criteria that are used to select candidates to receive contributions include:

- The candidate's views on issues of importance to American Express;
- The candidate's position on a committee with jurisdiction over policy issues important to American Express (e.g., the banking, commerce, and tax-writing committees in Congress);
- The candidate's representation of a state or district where American Express has an employee presence; and,
- The candidate's elected leadership position.

AXP PAC is bi-partisan and maintains a goal of dividing contributions within a 60-40 ratio between the two major parties.

AXP PAC does not contribute to presidential campaigns. AXP PAC candidate contributions are also publicly available by visiting the Federal Election Commission website.

## REVISED:

The AXP PAC supports candidates, committees and national parties based upon a variety of factors. These criteria include:

- Views on issues of importance to American Express;
- Position on a committee with jurisdiction over policy issues important to American Express (e.g., the banking, commerce, and tax-writing committees in Congress);
- Representation of a state or district where American Express has an employee presence;
- Elected leadership position;
- Character and integrity; and
- Commitment to policies that support diverse and inclusive communities.

AXP PAC is bi-partisan and maintains a goal of dividing contributions within a 60-40 ratio between the two major parties.

AXP PAC does not contribute to presidential campaigns.
