

### **IMPLEMENTING ACTS** Procedure for

Implementing Acts (Article 291 TFEU)



Delegated acts	Implementing acts
* measures of <b>general</b> scope that <b>add, insert, delete or modify non-essential elements</b> of the legislative act * mostly the <b>Annex</b>	* when <b>uniform conditions</b> for <b>implementation</b> are required * e.g.: taxation, agriculture, the internal market, health and food safety, energy, environment
* there are <b>no "formal" committees</b> involved * <b>basic act</b> may require " <b>opinion-giving</b> " committees to be consulted by the Commission	* "classic" traditional comitology * committees of Member State representatives * usually subject matter experts * vote on behalf of their government
* scope, duration of the delegation, veto deadlines are provided for in each legislative act * non-binding Memorandum of Understanding between the EP, the Council, and Commission	* horizontal procedural rules: "comitology" regulation since 2011 * basic acts refer to it in an article on "Committee procedure"
* supplement or amend certain non-essential elements of a legislative act.	* cannot add, insert, delete or modify any provision in the basic act * they are separate acts
* Council or EP may object to a delegated act * only after it has been adopted by the Commission * neither can amend it at any point	* EP has a very limited role in implementing acts  * Council only involved if it is the one adopting an implementing act (rare)  * Member state representatives in committees aren't "Council" (it's a Commission meeting)  * qualified majority needed against it  * sometimes in the Appeal Committee also, to veto it

# DIFFERENCES BETWEEN IMPLEMENTING ACT ("COMITOLOGY") COMMITTEES AND EXPERT GROUPS

Implementing act committees have a limited scope: control of the implementing powers of the Commission

Implementing act committees are always created by the legislator

Implementing act committees are composed of all Member States

Opinions delivered by implementing act committees have a direct impact on the decision-making process

Expert groups: advice and expertise to the Commission for the preparation of legislative proposals; policy initiatives and delegated acts, as well as for the implementation of existing legislation


Expert groups normally established by the Commission. In some cases – which should be the exception – set up by the legislator


Expert groups may be composed of individuals, organisation in the broad sense of the word and Member States' authorities

Opinions of expert groups cannot bind the Commission
