





- Brazil has approved key reforms in recent years, and it is gradually working towards improving its regulatory framework to attract investments and boost its competitiveness.
- Nevertheless, fiscal policy is still the main constraint to long-term sustained growth.
- **Tax reform** will impact business, as well as the relation between Federal, State and Local governments.
- New political dynamics lead to fragmentation, as Brazilian presidents are not strong as they used to be, and hence there are more channels through which to convey agendas.
- It also means civil society organizations have risen in power and increased their scrutiny of companies.
- All in all, the fast-paced change in Brazil's outlook demands nimble risk management and a strategic approach to decision-making processes.
