- 1994 Congressional Asian Pacific American Caucus (CAPAC)

Structure and Function of the Tri-Caucus

- Predominantly Democratic.
- House-focused. All Caucuses are organization authorized by the House
 Administration Committee. Senators usually contribute with staff instead of dues.
- Collaboration enhances their ability to influence legislation.
- Factors determining direction of each caucus: leadership, taskforce assignments, and member demographics.
