

## What is Generative Al

- Generative AI is a type of Artificial Intelligence that creates new content based on what it has learned from existing content.
- The process of learning from existing content is called training, which results in the creation of a statistical model.
- When given a prompt, GenAl uses this statistical model to predict what an expected response might be.




## Gemini 101

#### What's Gemini?

Gemini (formerly Bard) is a conversational Al tool that lets you collaborate with generative Al. It's grounded in Google's understanding of quality information.

## What powers Gemini?

Gemini is powered by a large language model. LLMs are generative AI models that can predict words that are likely to come next, based on the user's prompt.



# Prompt Engineering 101

The way you ask Gemini really makes a big difference in the quality of the responses. So we wanted to share some lessons that helped us improve prompt writing.

The anatomy of a great prompt:

```
[Give a role] [Define the goal]
[Specify audience] [Set Restrictions
/Style] [Format the result]
```

\*It's not necessary to always employ every one of these practices but make sure you are adopting the necessary ones where relevant

#### From good to great prompts

(INSTEAD OF THIS

What is prompt engineering?

TRY THIS

Explain prompt engineering to a 5th grader. Answer in bullet points that are 1 to 3 sentences. Use cookie Monster as the illustrative example.

(instead of this

Help me incorporate more high-protein vegan options in my diet

TRY THIS

You're a nutritionist. Show me a high protein vegan weekly meal plan with recipes that can be prepared in under 20 minutes. Put it in a chart by meal and day of the week.

# Understand and anticipate the other side of an issue

#### The Prompt:

You are an MEP in a debate on the EU Al Act, give me the three best liberal and three best conservative arguments on the four levels of risk for Al systems.

[Format the result]
```

# Get help thinking through how to effectively message specific subsets of the population

#### The Prompt:

You are a Communications Officer at the European Parliament. What is the most compelling way explain to young people the importance of civic engagement?

[Format the result]
```

# Brainstorm campaign tactic ideas to increase visibility amongst a particular audience

#### The Prompt:

You are a Member of the Belgian Parliament. Provide me with a list of 5 specific campaign ideas to increase your visibility among young people in Brussels.

```

[Specify audience] [Set Restrictions/Style]
[Format the result]
```

# Compare global and/or national laws

#### The Prompt:

Compare GDPR with China's Data protection law. Put it in a table.

# **Identify trends**

#### The Prompt:

What were some of the high-level themes the 2024 Maastricht Debate touched on. Put it in a table.

# Translating official statements/documents

# Draft a social media post that expresses a position on a certain issue

#### The Prompt:

# Get a head start drafting a response to citizens

# Map stakeholders

### The Prompt:

Give me the top 5 journalists writing about Artificial Intelligence in Brussels.

Only consider top tier publications.

#### Queries for day-to-day use for Gemini

#### Plan logistics on the campaign trail with Gemini

"Write me a road trip itinerary for Tuscany with a stop in Florence. Please include options for ice cream shops along the way"

#### Thank you email to donors with **Gemini**

"Help me write a thank you note to guests of my event for their continued support."

#### Connect with constituents with help from Gemini

"Help me come up with a few creative ways to engage young people in my community?"

#### Stay current on social media with ideas from Gemini

"Create some video ideas based off popular trends on YouTube"

#### Write a strong speech with **Gemini**
