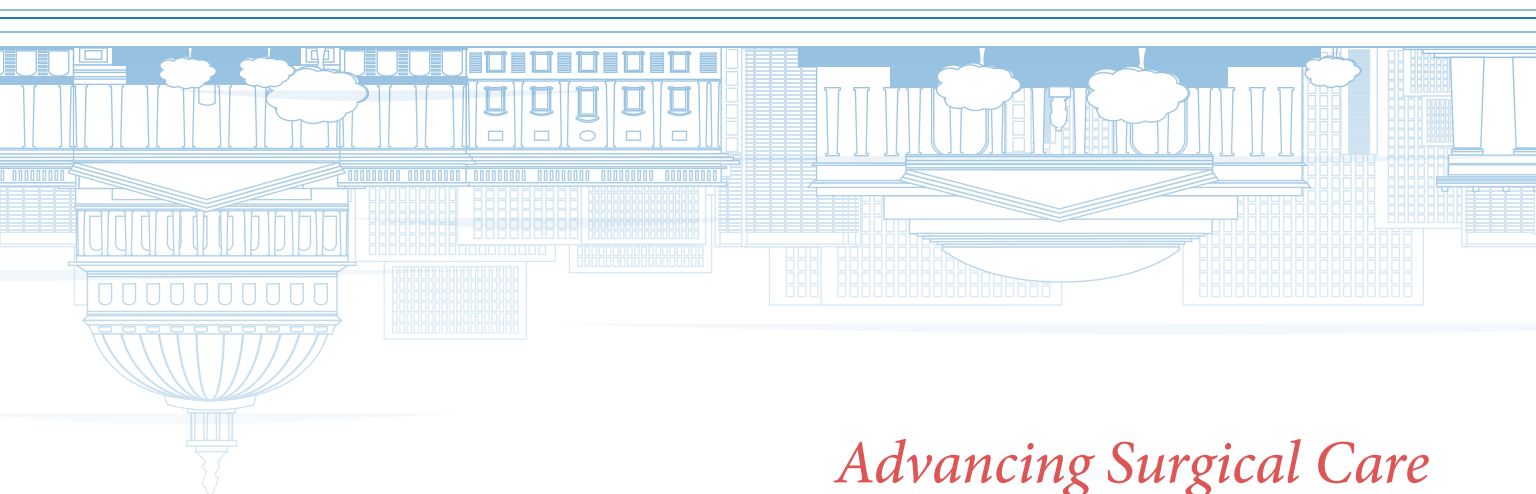

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MISSION STATEMENT

To advocate for surgeons and surgical patients by providing bipartisan financial support to pro-surgery candidates who share surgery's perspective on health care policy issues and are positioned to impact the future of surgical practice.







Dear Fellow Contributor,

You recognize that by being politically active at the federal level you personally help to ensure that our patients and profession are protected from harmful policies that could affect the future of our practice environment. On behalf of the American College of Surgeons Professional Association Political Action Committee (ACSPA-*SurgeonsPAC*) Board of Directors, thank you for your investment in advocacy this year. With your support, in 2017 *SurgeonsPAC* raised over \$500,000 from more than 1,270 ACSPA members and staff, and disbursed nearly \$380,000 to more than 100 U.S. House and Senate candidates, leadership PACs, and political campaign committees. The College's Board of Governors, Health Policy Advisory Council (HPAC), Health Policy and Advocacy Group (HPAG), and Regents and Officers continue to lead by example, with many increasing their commitments this year.

Even in the current challenging political environment, the American College of Surgeons (ACS) must continue to play a proactive role in meaningful health policy proposals for Congress to consider. Our overarching goals include improving surgical patient care and safeguarding standards of that care within an ethical practice environment for our profession. It is up to us, ACSPA-*SurgeonsPAC* supporters, to ensure these improvements take place. *SurgeonsPAC* is one of our most valuable tools to continue strengthening surgery through political engagement on Capitol Hill. In 2017, the federal legislative team attended more than 200 health care industry events leveraging relationships with key Congressional champions and their staffs. The Division of Advocacy and Health Policy (DAHP) also focused on an extensive list of federal legislative priorities, including reducing administrative practice burdens, modifying and implementing new physician payment reforms, improving electronic health record and health information technology interoperability, increasing funding for trauma systems, enhancing cancer care and accreditation, addressing surgical workforce and graduate medical education issues, and many more.

The federal legislative team works on our behalf in Washington to establish new relationships with policymakers who care about our issues. It is our duty as members and leaders of this esteemed organization to educate all of our colleagues and trainees about the importance of political advocacy, particularly supporting our PAC.

Our peers recognized in this annual report are to be commended for their unwavering commitment to the critical role that *SurgeonsPAC* plays in the political process. With the 2018 midterm elections right around the corner, *SurgeonsPAC* must be stronger than ever. While we are proud to be recognized among the top health professional PACs, we have the bandwidth to rise to the top. With increased PAC support, we are well positioned to do so while building on recent victories and advocating for meaningful, practical policies at the federal level.

None of this would be possible without your sustained support. By working together with your fellow ACSPA members, you are helping to ensure that we continue advancing surgical care through advocacy.

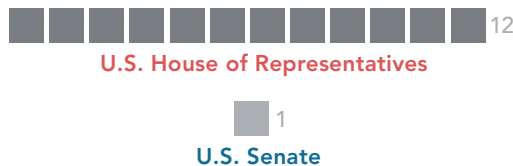

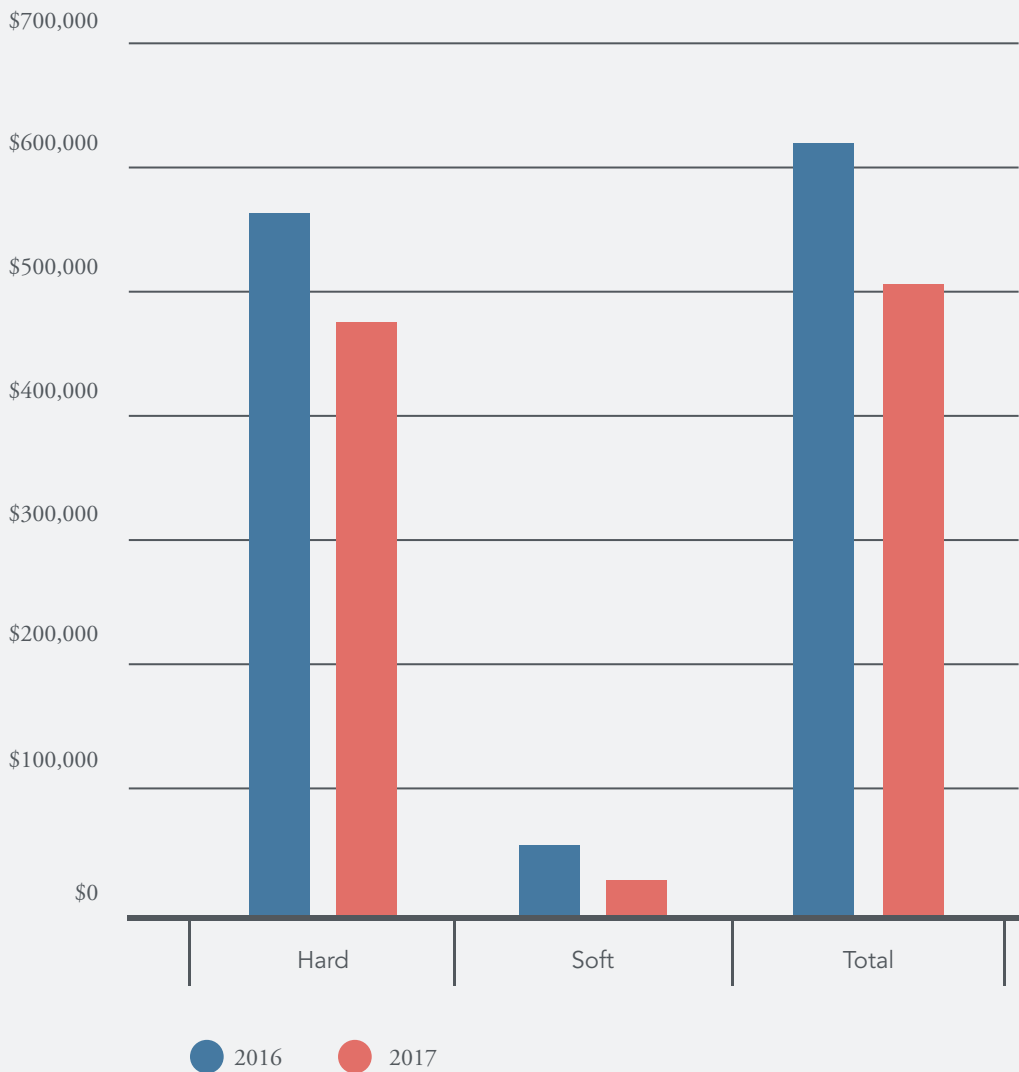

SurgeonsPAC Fundraising Overview

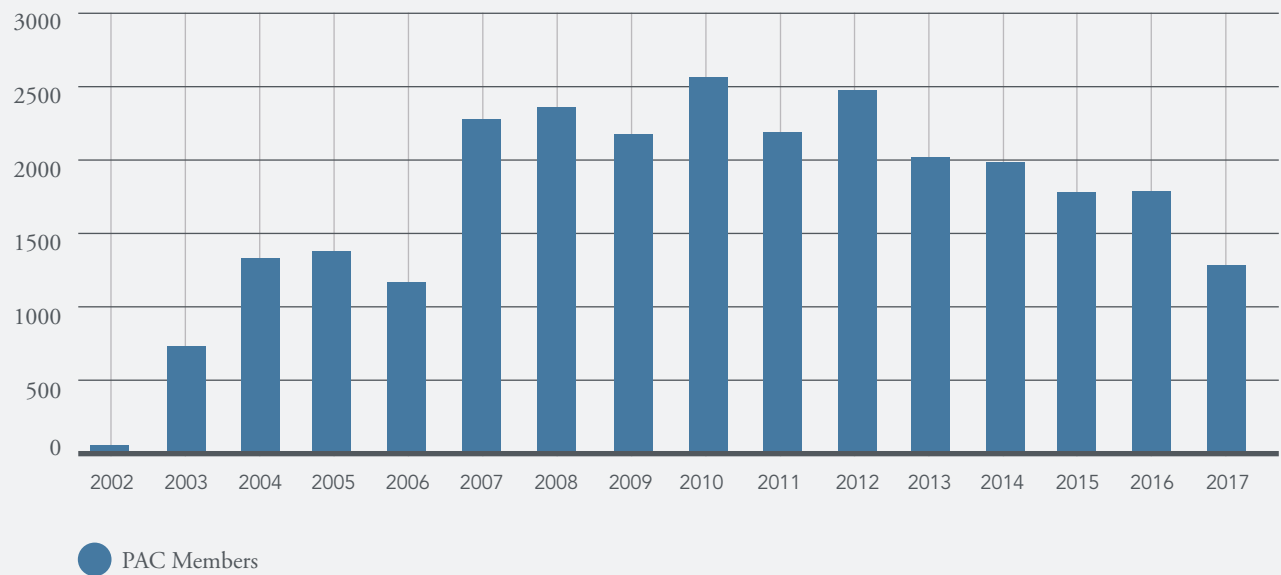

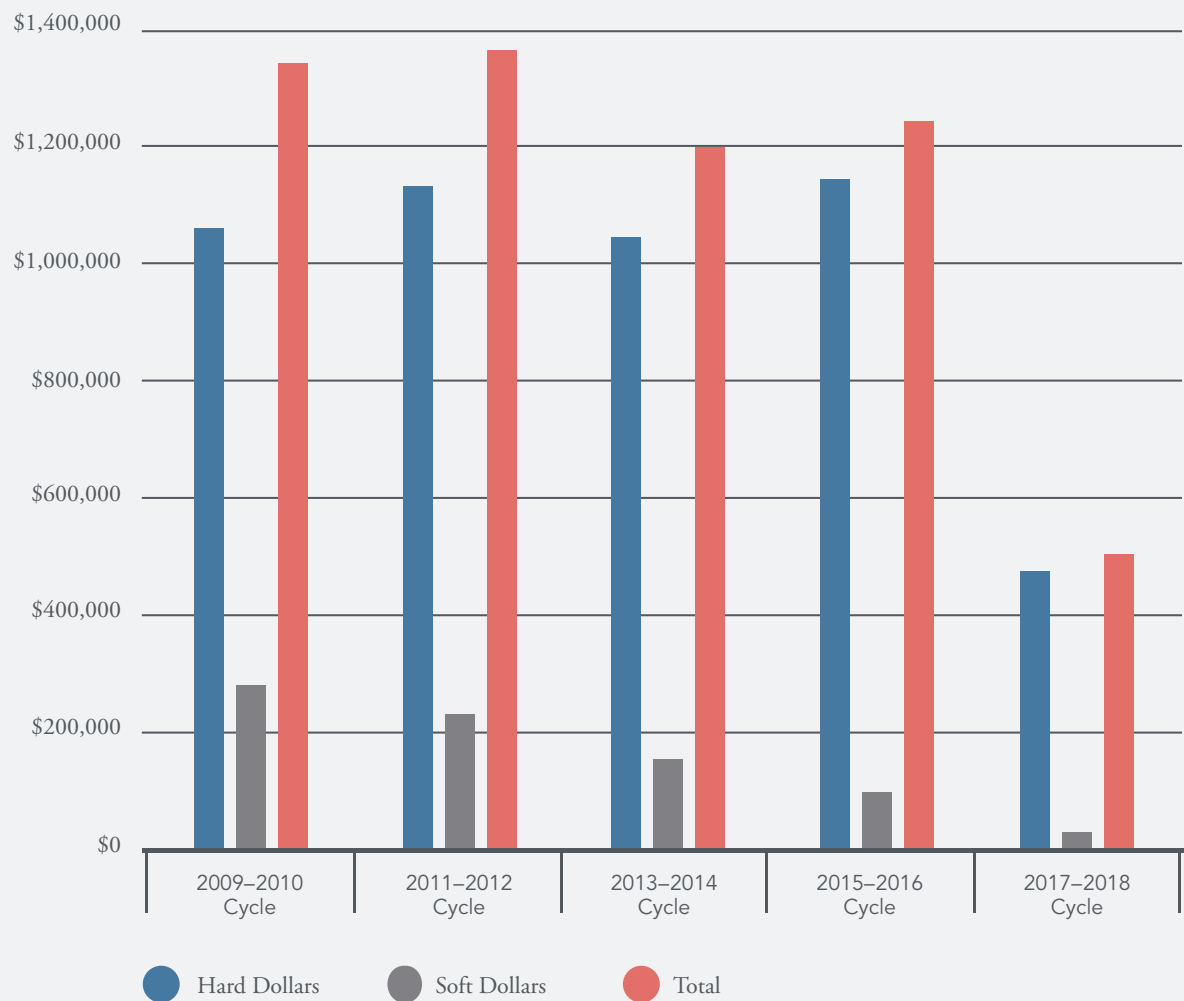
2016–2017 Fundraising Comparison



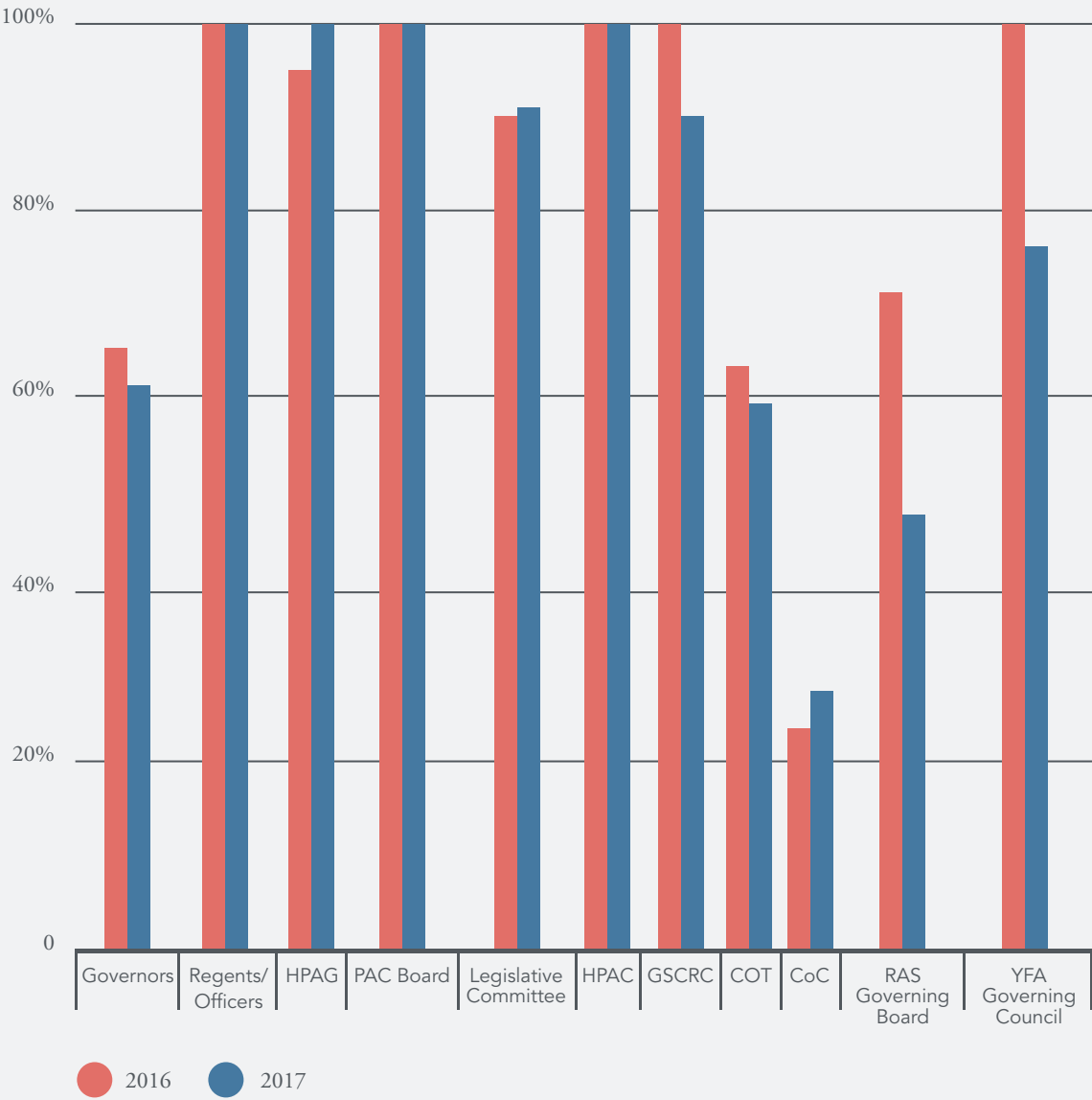

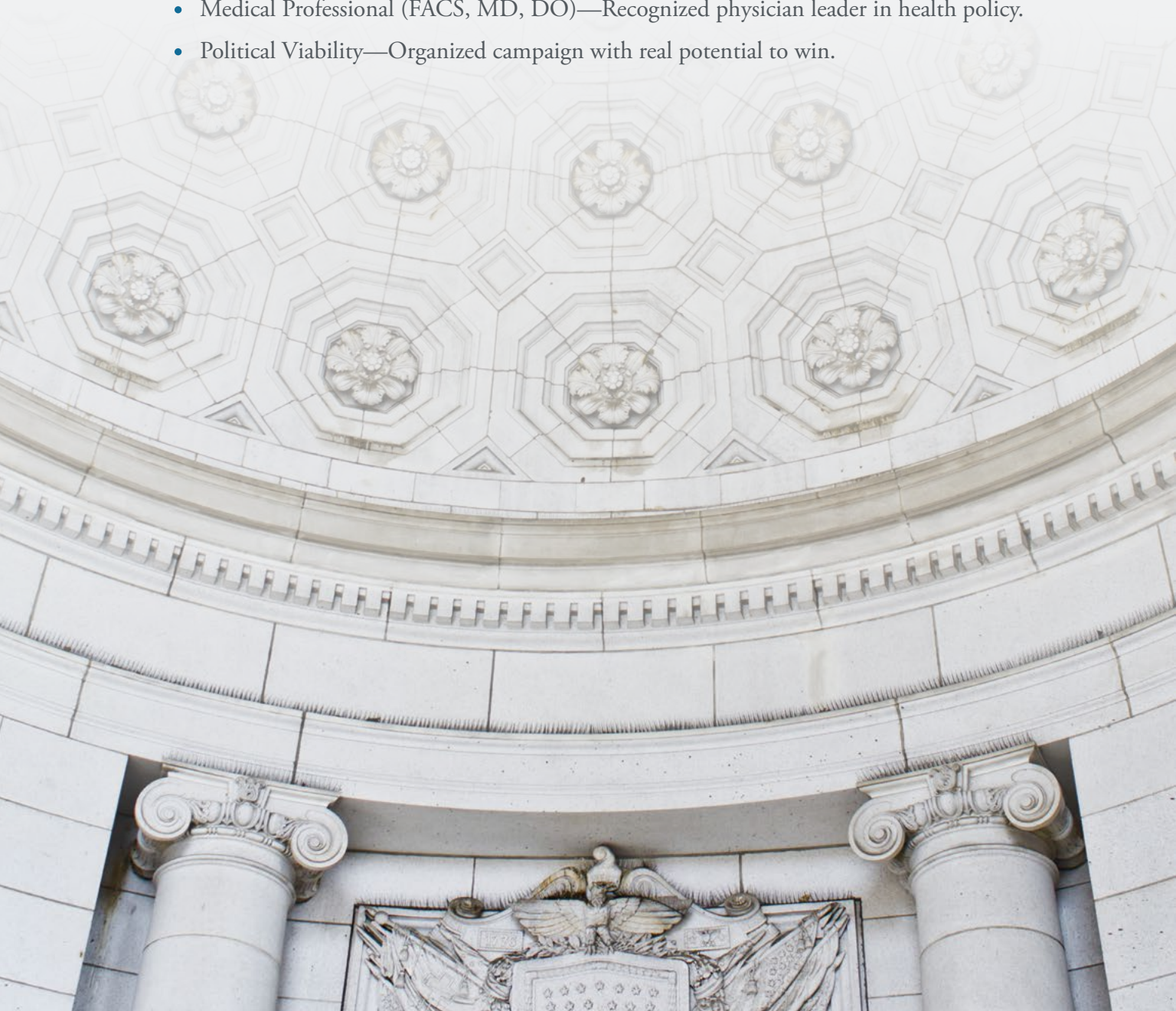


SurgeonsPAC Disbursement Overview

SurgeonsPAC, in conjunction with the College's federal legislative team and surgeon advocates, works on your behalf to establish relationships with surgical champions on Capitol Hill. In turn, the ACSPA-*SurgeonsPAC* Board and *SurgeonsPAC* staff empower the College's health policy agenda through prudent stewardship of contributions.

The following guidelines shape our candidate disbursement strategy:

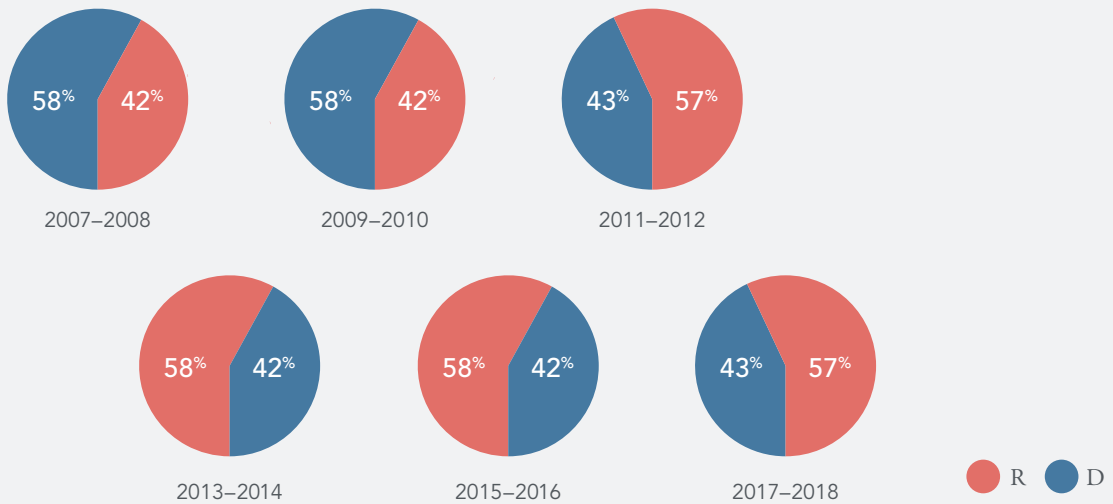
- Leadership Position—Ability of the candidate to affect which pieces of legislation move forward and impact each respective party's position on the issue.
- Committee Assignment—Ability of the candidate to advance health policy legislation in support of surgeons and the surgical patient.
- Record on Issues—Serve as a champion for surgery and the surgical patient.
- Medical Professional (FACS, MD, DO)—Recognized physician leader in health policy.
- Political Viability—Organized campaign with real potential to win.

Disbursement Ratios 2007–2018



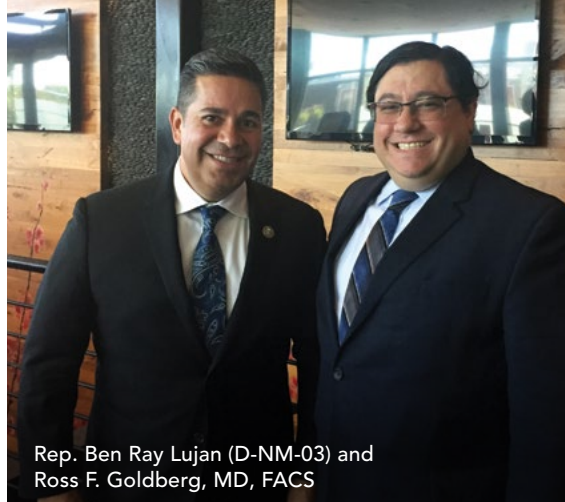

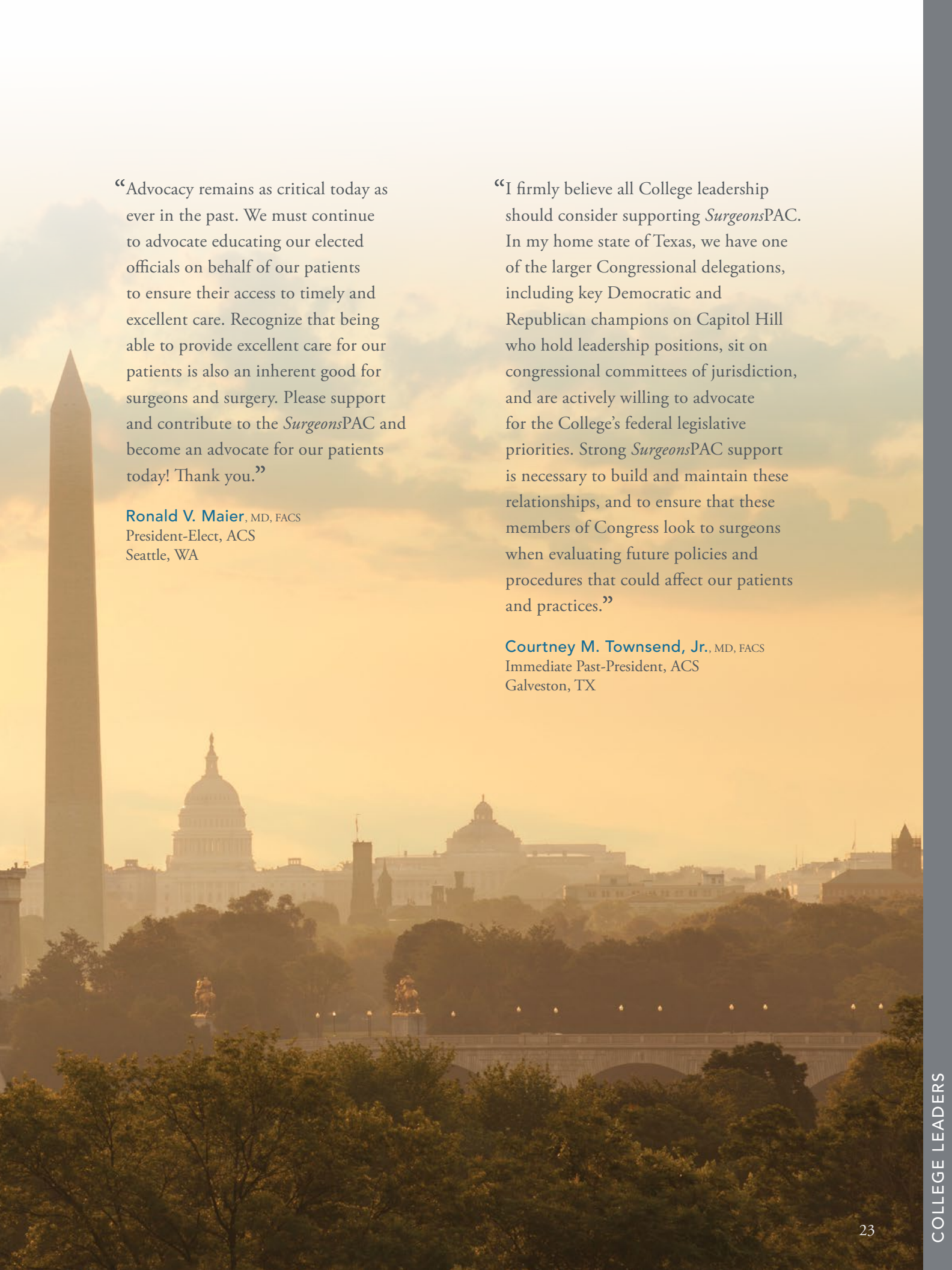

SurgeonsPAC FACTS

SurgeonsPAC is regulated by Federal Election Commission (FEC) laws. The following information is vital to successful and lawful *SurgeonsPAC* fundraising and recruiting efforts.

- Only ACS members, and their spouses, can be solicited for *SurgeonsPAC* contributions. Solicitation to nonmembers and the general public is prohibited.
- *SurgeonsPAC* only accepts contributions from U.S. citizens and foreign citizens lawfully admitted for permanent residence (green card holders).
- The maximum contribution allowed to *SurgeonsPAC* is \$5,000 annually per individual.
- Contributions to *SurgeonsPAC* are completely voluntary. Members may choose not to contribute without reprisal.
- Federal law requires political action committees to report the name, mailing address, occupation, and name of employer for each individual whose contributions exceed \$200 in a calendar year.
- An FEC disclaimer must be included on all fundraising solicitations.
- Only personal or noncorporate checks or credit cards are accepted by *SurgeonsPAC*. Contributions cannot be reimbursed by an employer. Corporate contributions are referred to as “soft” fundraising dollars and are used for administrative purposes only.



The *SurgeonsPAC* Board also encourages you to remind your colleagues of the following points:

- *SurgeonsPAC* brings a national focus to local issues, so it is important to stay involved at both the local and the national levels.
- *SurgeonsPAC* offers contributor levels as low as \$25 annually.

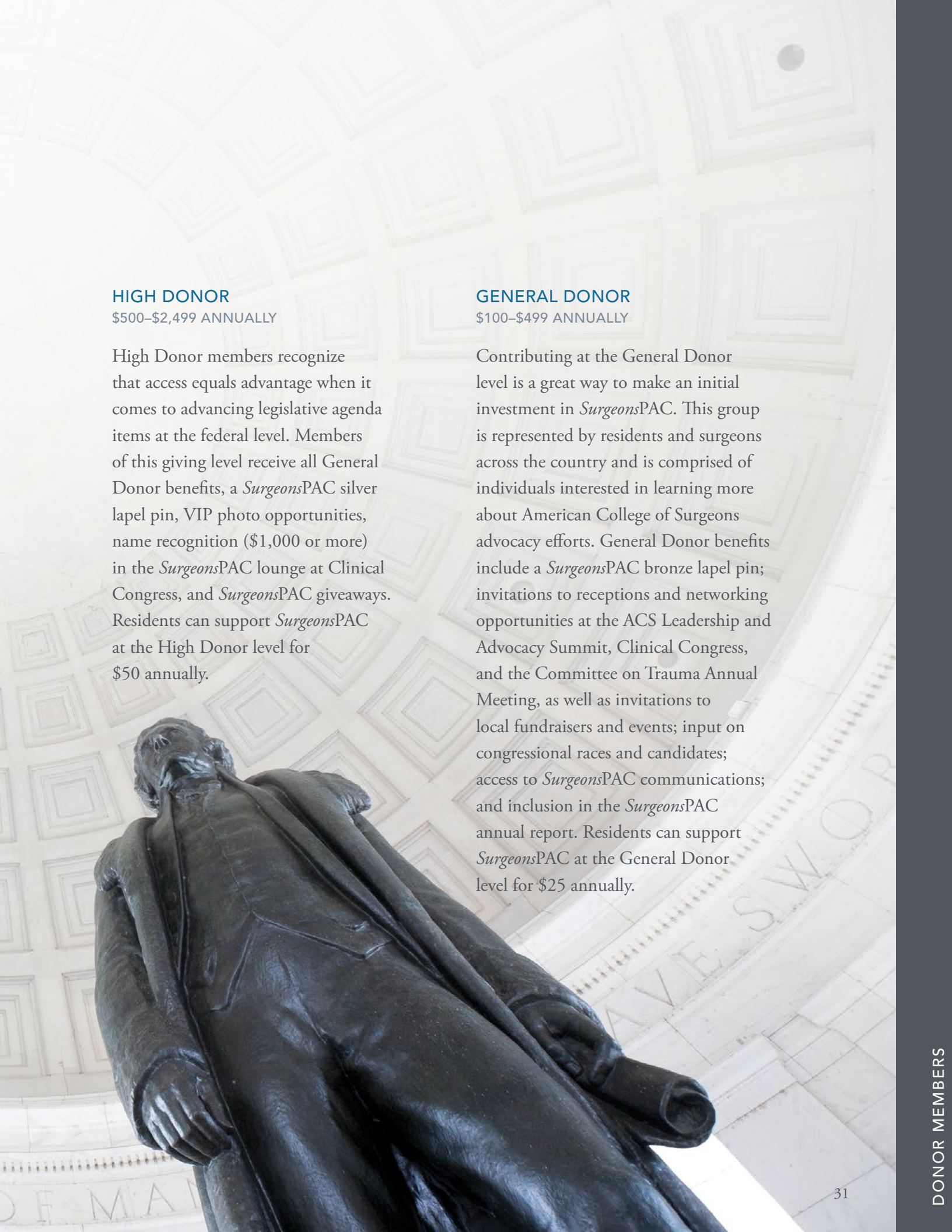

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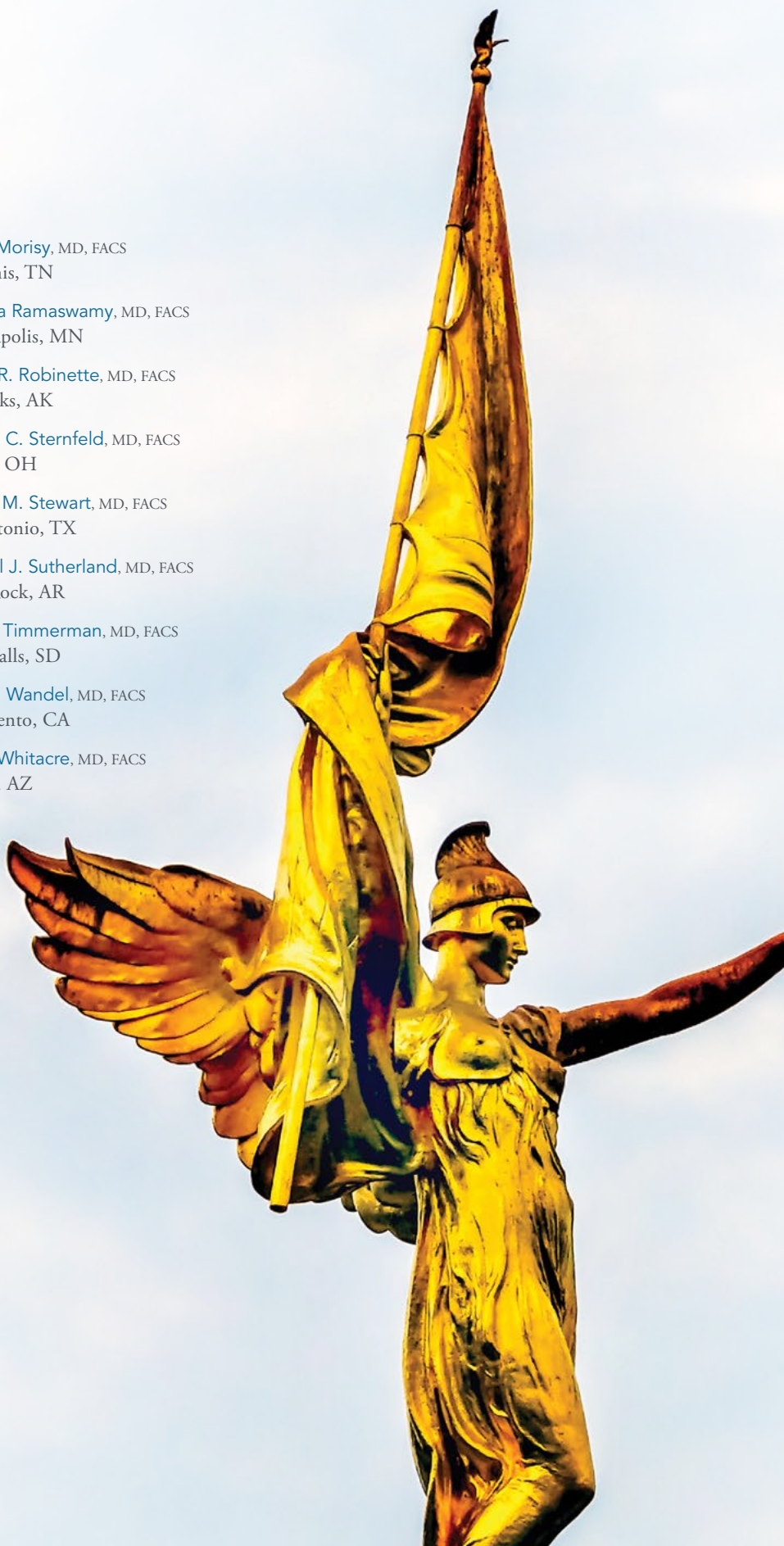
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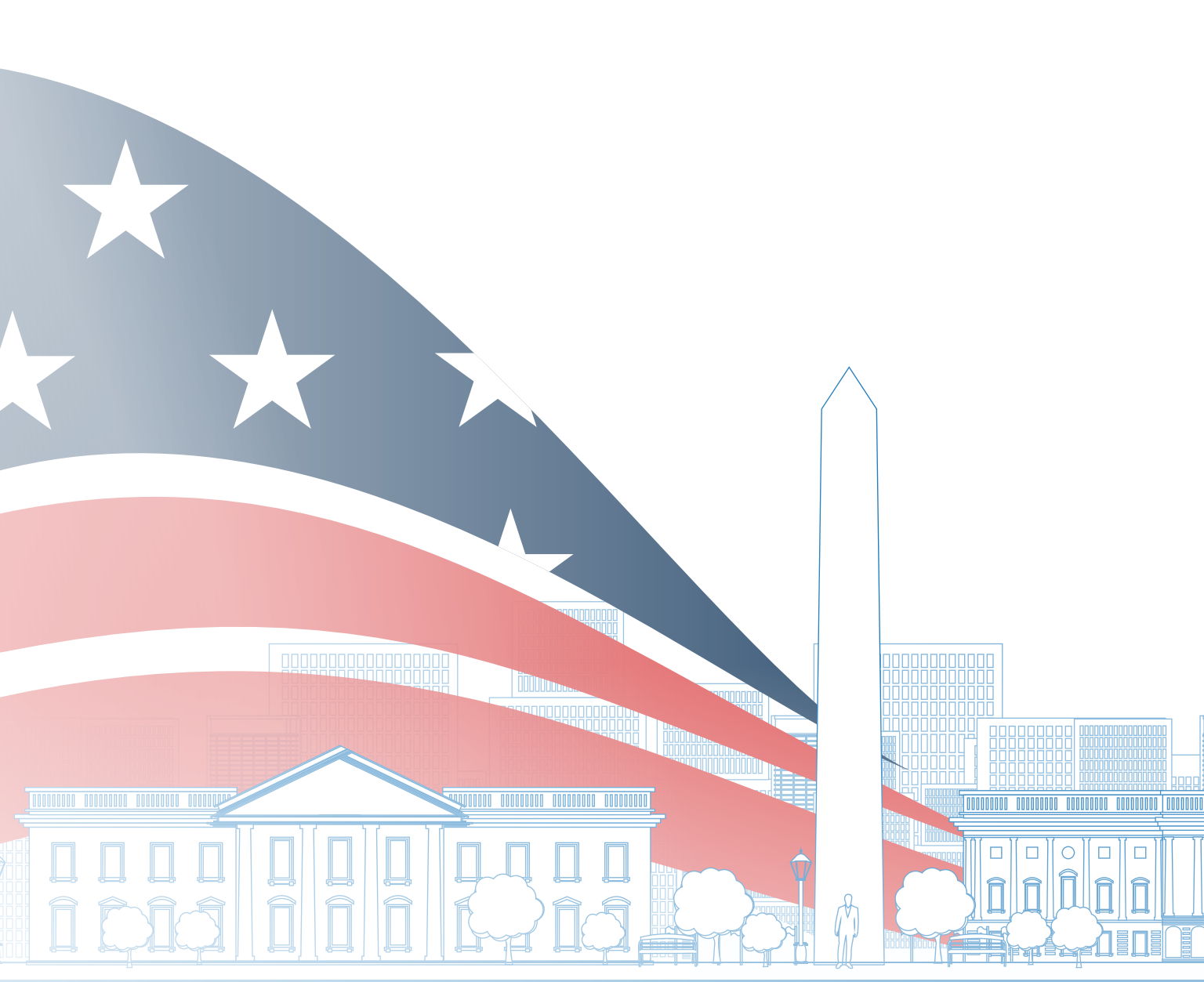


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
