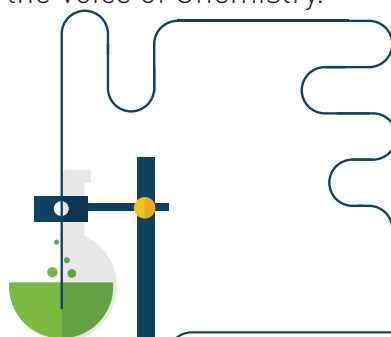

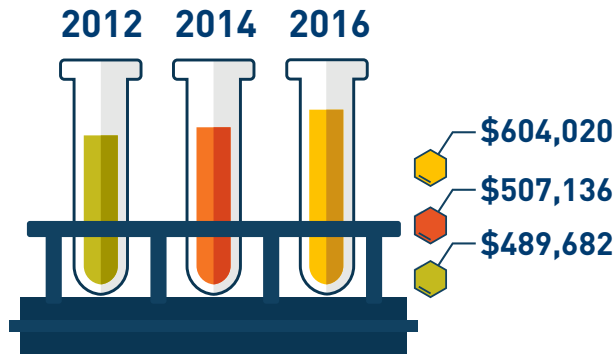

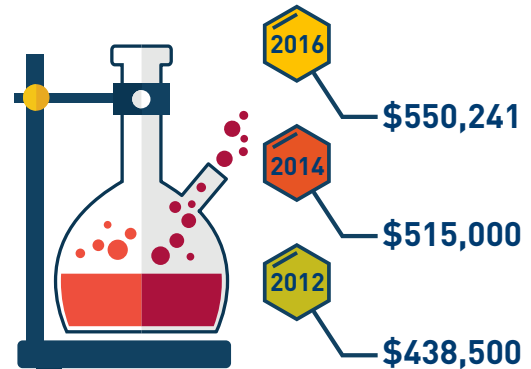

This chart represents the AmeriChem PAC total receipts from the 2012, 2014 and 2016 election cycles. Source: Federal Election Commission

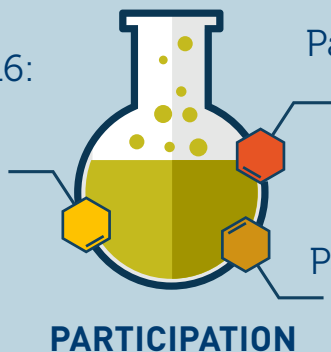
AmeriChem PAC Disbursements by Election Cycle

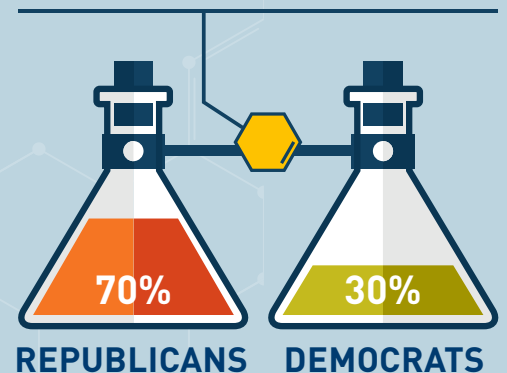
Disbursement Criteria

- > Demonstrates constructive approach to chemical industry issues
- > Serves on the legislative leadership team
- > Member of key congressional committee
- > Potential for election success
- > History of AmeriChem PAC support
- > Other (e.g., constituent service and in-district activity)

Every AmeriChem PAC contribution is reported to the Federal Election Commission (FEC), and those reports are made public on the FEC website.

Accomplishments

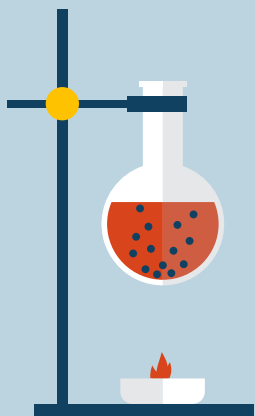
1. Secured passage of Frank R. Lautenberg Chemical Safety for the 21st Century Act (LCSA).
2. Established the ACC Center for Chemical Safety Act Implementation as a scientific, technical and advocacy resource for specific chemicals.
3. Secured drone legislation that prevents unauthorized drones near chemical facilities.
4. Raised over \$600,000 in 2016 election cycle for AmeriChem PAC – a record high for the PAC and an 18 percent increase over the previous election cycle.
5. Led effort to secure a congressional request for the Government Accountability Office (GAO) to review transportation infrastructure needs resulting from the chemical industry's expansion.
6. Secured significant changes benefiting the chemical industry in final and temporary regulations under section 385 of the Internal Revenue Code concerning the treatment of certain corporate interests as stock or indebtedness.

2017

Initiatives

1. **Tax Reform**- Ensure a pro-growth and pro-business outcome in any final tax reform package that is signed into law.
2. **Federal Labeling Initiative**- Successfully launch a legislative campaign to set minimum scientific standards for state labeling requirements.
3. **Materials Pipe Open Competition**- Advance requirements in transportation and infrastructure programs that would ensure open competition and competitive bidding for federally funded infrastructure projects.
4. **Stockholm and Rotterdam Conventions**- Seek Senate ratification of both conventions.
5. **IARC Oversight**- Continue legislative and oversight work to push for additional transparency and risk-based reforms to how the International Agency for Research on Cancer (IARC) conducts and presents their scientific work.
6. **Marine Debris**- Work to pass legislation that would codify and expand federal programs to support waste management in other countries, highlighting that marine debris is a waste management issue rather than a direct plastics production issue.
7. **Regulatory Reform**- Continue working to ensure that ACC priorities on scientific integrity and benefit-cost analysis are incorporated into final legislative packages that may become law.
8. **RMP**- Work to repeal the Environmental Protection Agency's final Risk Management Plan rule issued by President Obama at the end of his Administration.

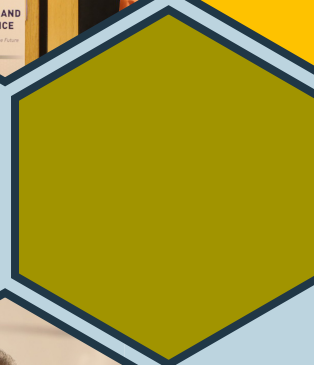
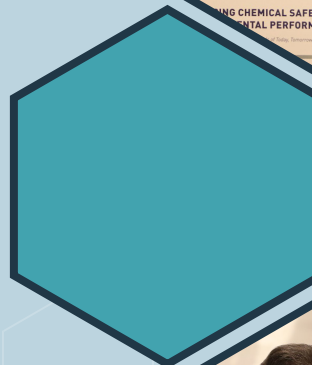


Total dollars raised for 2016 Election Cycle

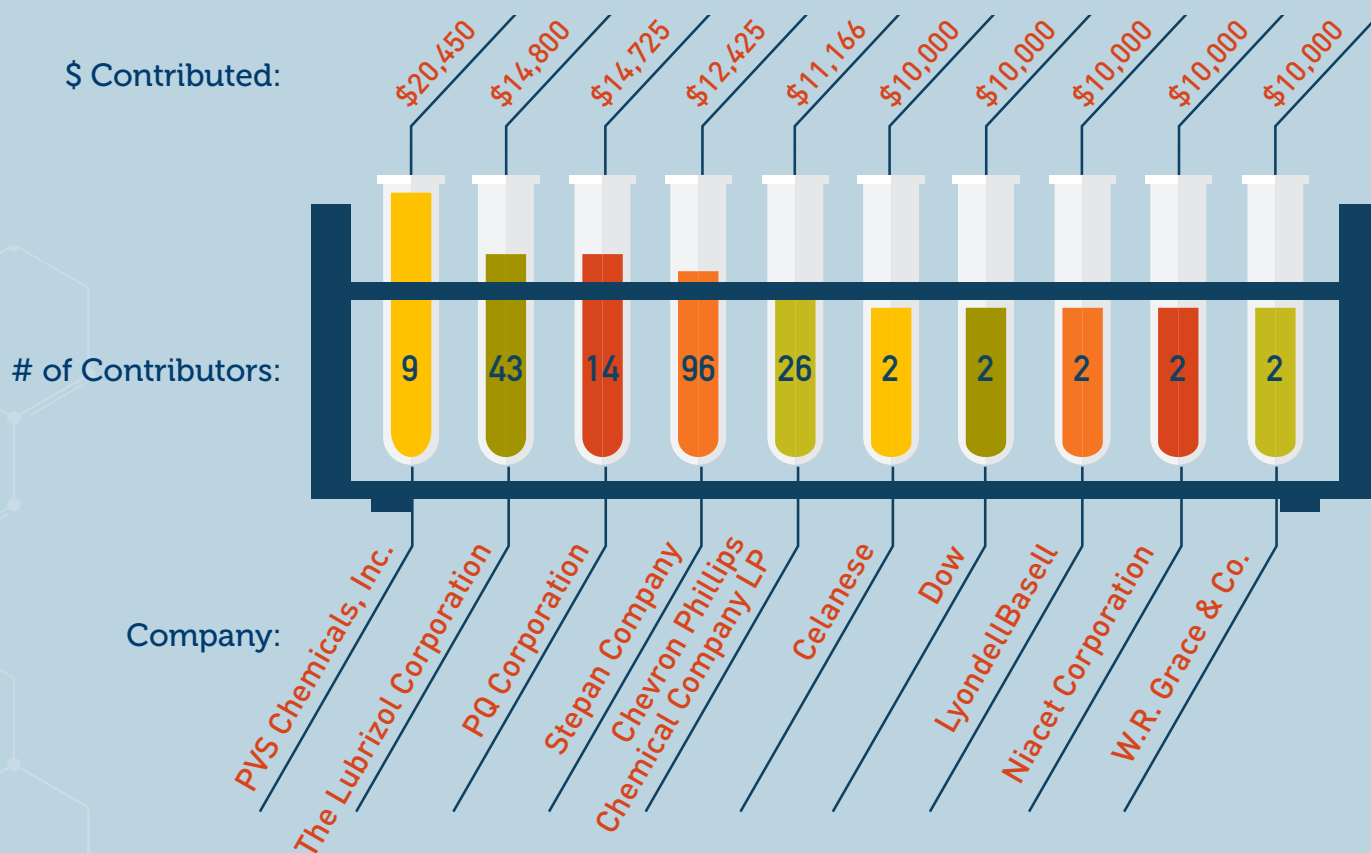

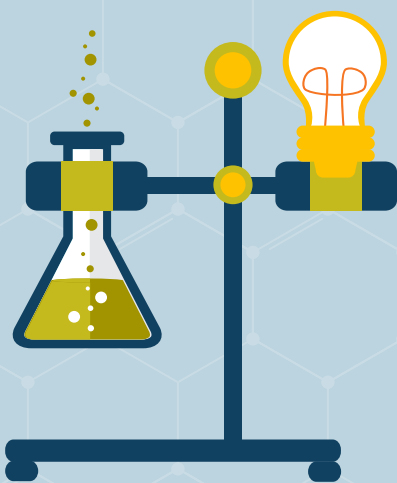
