Peer-to-peer Considerations



- ☐ Pick the right people
 - Nomination process or leadership selection?
 - How many Ambassadors do you need?
 - Will they serve for a term and roll off?
- Plan your funding
 - Will you support Ambassador-led events?
 - In-person fly-in or training?
- □ Training is MANDATORY
 - Legal do's and don'ts
 - FEC manual or a handbook
 - Explain why it is so important to follow the rules

Peer-to-peer Considerations Con't



- Provide regular support
 - Monthly call
 - Blog post
 - Website just for Ambassadors?
- Prepare them to make the "ask"
 - Make sure they are comfortable
 - Give them talking points
 - Possible questions they may receive
 - Make it easy!
- Recognize their efforts often
 - Say thank you with a gift
 - Recognition from leadership

Lessons Learned (the hard way)



- Don't give them a long leash
 - Make sure they come to you first!
- Expect the unexpected
- Make it as easy for them as possible
 - Draft emails
 - Prepare presentations
 - Do as much for them as you can
