

- OVERALL VOTER TURNOUT WAS DOWN
 - Only 58% of registered voters actually voted compared to 59% in 2012 and 62% in 2008.
- PRESIDENTIAL ELECTION WAS CLOSE

 For only the fifth time in history, the winner of the popular vote did not win the electoral college.
- PREDICTIONS WERE WRONG
