- Supports issues of importance to NiSource and our industry
- Represents a state or district where NiSource has employees or operations
- Serves in party leadership or on a committee with jurisdiction over issues important to NiSource and our industry
- Demonstrates electability through a viable campaign
- Opposes a candidate who consistently votes or takes positions counter to our interest
- Is endorsed by industry trade associations and/or other pro-business groups

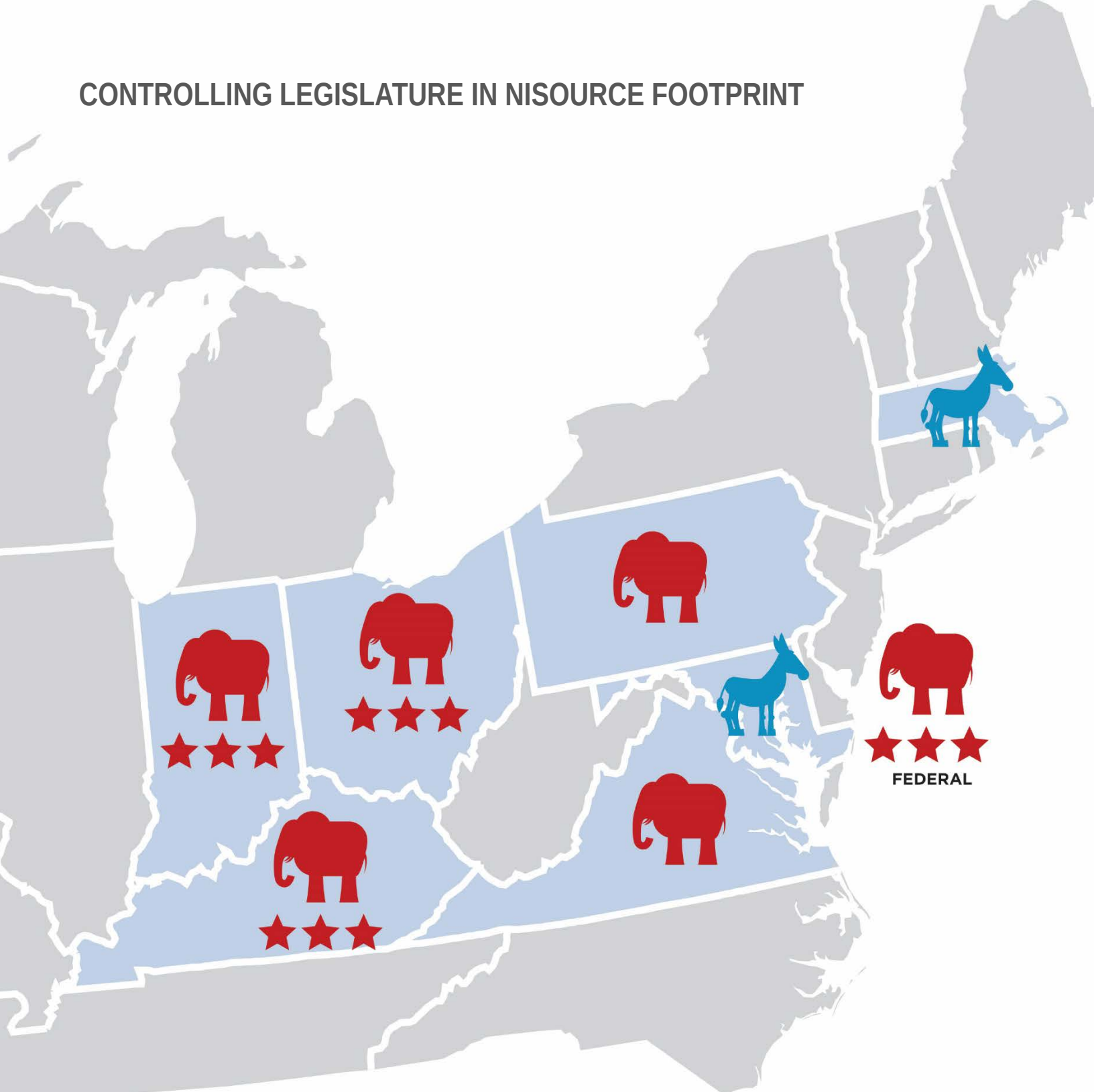
