Piper Evans is the manager of the government relations practice for the Public Affairs Council. Piper serves as the lead expert for the Council on federal and state government relations, and is the primary contact to the public affairs community on best practices and emerging trends in these areas. Piper advises members on effective strategies for communicating with Congress, state legislatures, the Administration and regulatory agencies. She provides guidance and counsel to enhance DC and state capital lobbying practices, ensuring maximum government affairs impact for the Council's 600-plus member organizations.

Before joining the Council, Piper was the Legislative Specialist for Chevron Corporation, where she worked on tracking and analyzing legislation and regulation, both at the federal and state levels, and aided in the formation of multiple oil and gas industry advocacy efforts. Piper coordinated Chevron's Get Back to Work campaign in 2010 and 2011, helping to ensure a safe return to work in the Gulf of Mexico. She also contributed to multiple company advocacy plans, focusing on issues such as shale gas, through the implementation of stakeholder engagement initiatives.

Piper started her career as a staff assistant for Congresswoman Lynn Woolsey (CA-6), where she worked on Capitol Hill to support constituent relations.

A native of New York City, Piper graduated with a bachelor of arts in government and international relations from George Mason University. She is working towards her private pilot's license.
