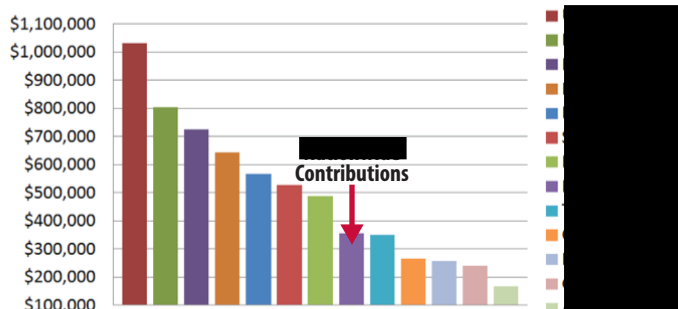
## Is the [REDACTED] PAC Non-Partisan?

The [REDACTED] PAC Membership list is strictly confidential and is not circulated for reasons other than for PAC administration and operation.

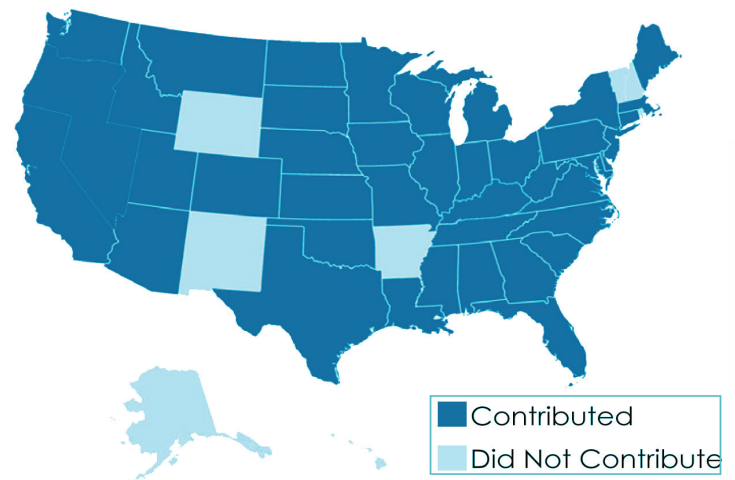

These contributions are approved by a chairperson and advisory board consisting of [REDACTED] associates and agents.
