

- kittens nap in the sunlight. Big trees loom overhead. Inside, Herve has made the three-room space – a kitchen, bedroom, and study – his own.



James Altman, Division Chief of Administration for the Santa Monica Fire Department. He oversees a team of paramedics, who are on the front lines of handling 911 calls related to homelessness.

"Our hands are tied in most cases. We don't have sobriety centers that we can transport to, no alternative destinations that we can transport to. The only place we can take them is the hospital even if we know they shouldn't be there." James Altman, former paramedic and fire chief for the Santa Monica Fire Department.
