




### **States with 2016 Gubernatorial Elections**






### States with Term-Limited Governors in 2016, 2017 & 2018




### **Current Legislative Party Control**




#### **2016 Ballot Measures:** Which States Will Vote to Raise the Minimum Wage?




### Which states still have outstanding budgets?


