



- Drafting testimony and comments
- In-state services include presenting testimony, training volunteers, participating in advocacy forums, negotiating legislation and other proceedings (in-person/virtual)
- Drafting legislation and amendments
- Analysis of legislation and regulations
- Collaborating, brainstorming and developing legislative, regulatory and court strategies
- Identifying emerging advocacy issues and trends
- Developing written policy analysis and advocacy resources
- Developing and collaborating on collateral materials for ballot, legislative and regulatory efforts; including targeted population collateral
- Building organizational issue knowledge
- Collaborating on conceptualizing and organizing issue summits to enhance legislative and implementation strategies
