Public affairs on social media – Best practices

- Be professional at all times
- Use hashtags and tag people but don't lose message
 - Link to/combine with real events/conferences
 - Link to/between other social media platforms
 - Use images it just works!
- Use TweetDeck or similar to stack up tweets going forward
 - Block any follower which is clearly improper
 - Be yourself Not just corporate and faceless
 - Balance Law of Goldilocks!
