

THE ALZHEIMER'S EPIDEMIC IN AMERICA

- Every 68 seconds another American develops Alzheimer's, and as the baby boomers get older, these numbers will double.
- Alzheimer's is the only cause of death among the top 10 in America without a way to prevent, cure or even slow its progression.
- Of those Americans aged 65 and over, 1 in 8 will develop Alzheimer's.
- Today, more than 5 million Americans are living with Alzheimer's disease. By 2050, up to 16 million will have the disease.
- Caring for people with Alzheimer's disease will cost the United States \$20 trillion in today's money during the next 40 years. The overwhelming majority will be paid by Medicare and Medicaid.

We need a widespread commitment to end this rapidly growing epidemic.

Alzheimer's can't wait and families won't forget.
We need to find a cure now.







Feel: Key details/story/supporting info


Do: The ask/challenge/instructions

CARE PLANNING


The HOPE for Alzheimer's Act (S. 857/H.R. 1559) would:

- Provide Medicare coverage for comprehensive care planning services – for both the individual and caregiver – following a dementia diagnosis.
- Ensure a dementia diagnosis and care planning are documented in the medical record.
- Educate providers about the new benefit.

ALZHEIMER'S DISEASE IS THE SIXTH LEADING CAUSE OF DEATH IN THE UNITED STATES.

MORE THAN 5 MILLION AMERICANS ARE LIVING WITH THE DISEASE.



In 2013, an estimated 450,000 people in the United States will die with Alzheimer's.



Since 2000, deaths from Alzheimer's have risen 68 percent while deaths from other major diseases have decreased.



1 in 3 seniors dies with Alzheimer's or another dementia.

NEARLY 15 PERCENT OF CAREGIVERS FOR PEOPLE WITH ALZHEIMER'S OR ANOTHER DEMENTIA ARE LONG-DISTANCE CAREGIVERS.

OUT-OF-POCKET EXPENSES FOR LONG-DISTANCE CAREGIVERS ARE NEARLY TWICE AS MUCH AS LOCAL CAREGIVERS.



IN 2012, CAREGIVERS PROVIDED OVER 17 BILLION HOURS OF UNPAID CARE VALUED AT MORE THAN \$216 BILLION.



There are more than 15 million caregivers of people with Alzheimer's and other dementias.



In 2013, Alzheimer's will cost the nation \$203 billion. This number is expected to rise to \$1.2 trillion by 2050.


