POLICIES AND PROCEDURES OF THE POLITICAL ACTION COMMITTEE OF THE AMERICAN ASSOCIATION OF ORTHOPAEDIC SURGEONS* (ORTHOPAEDIC PAC)

Adopted by the Board of Directors American Association of Orthopaedic Surgeons (Adopted February 6, 1999) (Amended May 14, 2016 [June 12, 2015])

ARTICLE I Names and Purpose

- A. Name. The name of this Political Action Committee (hereinafter "PAC") shall be the Political Action Committee of the American Association of Orthopaedic Surgeons (hereinafter "Orthopaedic PAC").
- B. Association. The American Association of Orthopaedic Surgeons (hereinafter "ASSOCIATION") shall be a not-for-profit membership organization, incorporated and located in and governed by the laws of the State of Illinois.
- C. Purpose. The purpose of the Orthopaedic PAC shall be to support candidates for federal office who have expressed real or potential interest in issues involving the provision of care to musculoskeletal patients and the maintenance and betterment of the profession of orthopaedic surgery.

ARTICLE II Orthopaedic PAC Executive Committee

- A. General Powers. The property, affairs, and business of the Orthopaedic PAC shall be managed and controlled by its Executive Committee (hereinafter "Orthopaedic PAC Executive Committee") that shall be named from time to time by the Board of Directors of the ASSOCIATION.
- B. Specific Powers. The Orthopaedic PAC Executive Committee shall be specifically charged to:
 - Develop a strategy for giving and make contributions within the federal limits to candidates (or to such candidates' authorized political or campaign committees) for federal office;
 - Solicit appropriate individuals for contributions to the Orthopaedic PAC in a legally appropriate manner;




