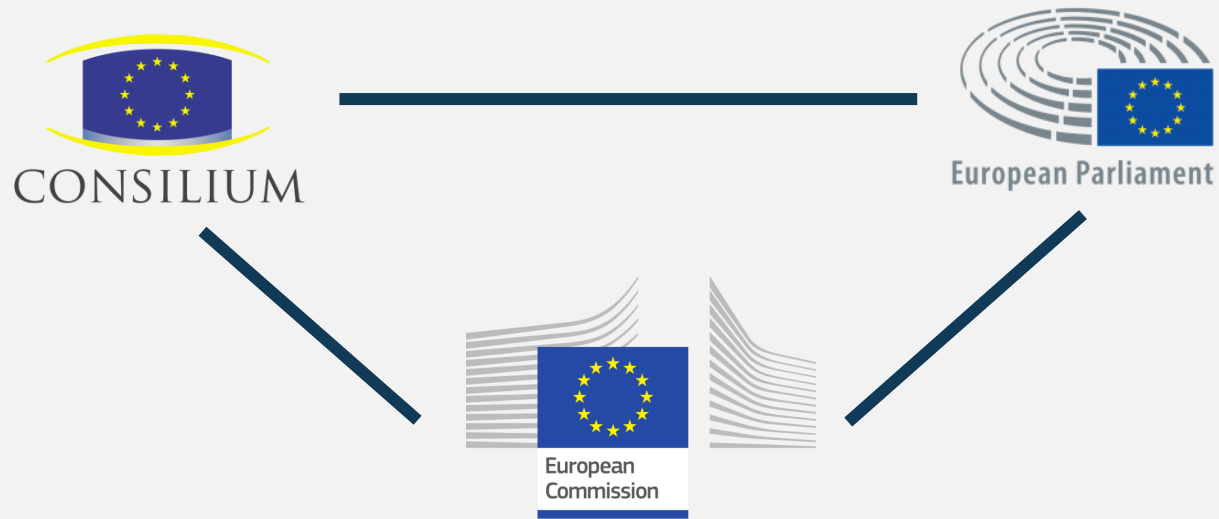
CHANGES AT FOUR STAGES IN THE EU DECISION-MAKING PROCESS
