The purpose of NiPAC is to make political contributions to candidates for public office. Contributions to NiPAC are voluntary, and employees may refuse to contribute without any reprisal. Guidelines for contributions are merely suggestions. Employees are free to contribute more or less than the guidelines suggest, and the company will not favor or disadvantage anyone by reason of the amount of their contribution or their decision not to contribute. In order to participate, you must be a U.S. Citizen or lawfully admitted for permanent residence in the United States. NiPAC is required to report the names and work addresses of individuals whose PAC contributions exceed \$200 per year to the Federal Election Commission and to comply with all applicable state disclosure requirements.
