## WHAT THE LAW SAYS:

It is necessary for us to obtain corporate approval before NRMCA CONCRETEPAC may solicit contributions from you or your employees. All CONCRETEPAC Contributions are Non-Tax Deductible. Your contribution to NRMCA CONCRETEPAC, or any other multi-candidate PAC, does not prohibit you from making personal contributions to the campaign committees or favorite candidates (limited to \$2,700 per candidate per election or \$5,000 per PAC per year). You are limited in that your corporation may not approve solicitations from more than one trade association for the same calendar year.

All <u>corporations</u> are prohibited from making contributions to political action committees, but their officers or employees are not prohibited from contributing on an <u>individual basis</u>. Copies of our reports are filed with the Federal Election Commission and are available for purchase from the agency's Washington, D.C. office at 999 E Street, N.W.
