






### **Road Map**

#### Wisconsin's hidden tech gems emerging

"There's innovation all over the county, all around the world," said Shapiro of the Consumer Technology Association. "What's changed in the last 20 or 30 years, dramatically, is with the internet, anyone with a broadband connection or some type of device, can create a company."

The association produces an **annual scorecard**, based on categories like internet speed, tech workforce and business investment. Wisconsin, North Dakota, Nebraska and Kansas all moved into the "Innovation Champion" category for the first time in the most recent edition.
