

LD-2 Reporting Method A

- Reporting amounts using LDA definitions only
 - Lobbying activity hours
 - Lobbying by outside consultants/firms
 - Trade Association lobbying
 - T&E expenses

Lobbying Hour Tracking

- Lobbying Activities: Lobbying contacts (any oral, written, or electronic communication to a covered official) and any efforts in support of such contacts, including preparation or planning activities, research, and other background work that is intended, at the time of its preparation, for use in contacts, and coordination with the lobbying activities of others.
- Track early and often!

Outside Lobby Consultants/Firms

Report the expense in the quarter in which service was provided

Trade Association Lobbying

- Contributions to "Association" are not tax deductible as charitable contributions. For 2014, XX% of contributions relates to lobbying and is not tax deductible; XX% may be deductible as a business expense.
- Report the expense in the quarter in which it was paid



- Transportation
- Meals
- Airline travel
- Lodging
- Aviation
