# THE AMGEN PAC AND PAC MATCH

- 2017-2018 Cycle Revenue: \$1.8 million
- ~8,000 PAC eligible staff nationwide
- 15% participation rate
- PAC Match program began in 2004
- Originally, the program offered dollar-for-dollar to all PAC members
- In 2016, we introduced Double PAC Match

## It's Your Choice:

- For all PAC members giving at the flat-dollar level, Amgen will match \$1-for-\$1 your contribution to a 501(c)(3) organization of your choice

- Can be split 50-50 between two organizations
- Contributions made in connection with the PAC-Match Gift Program are not tax-deductible

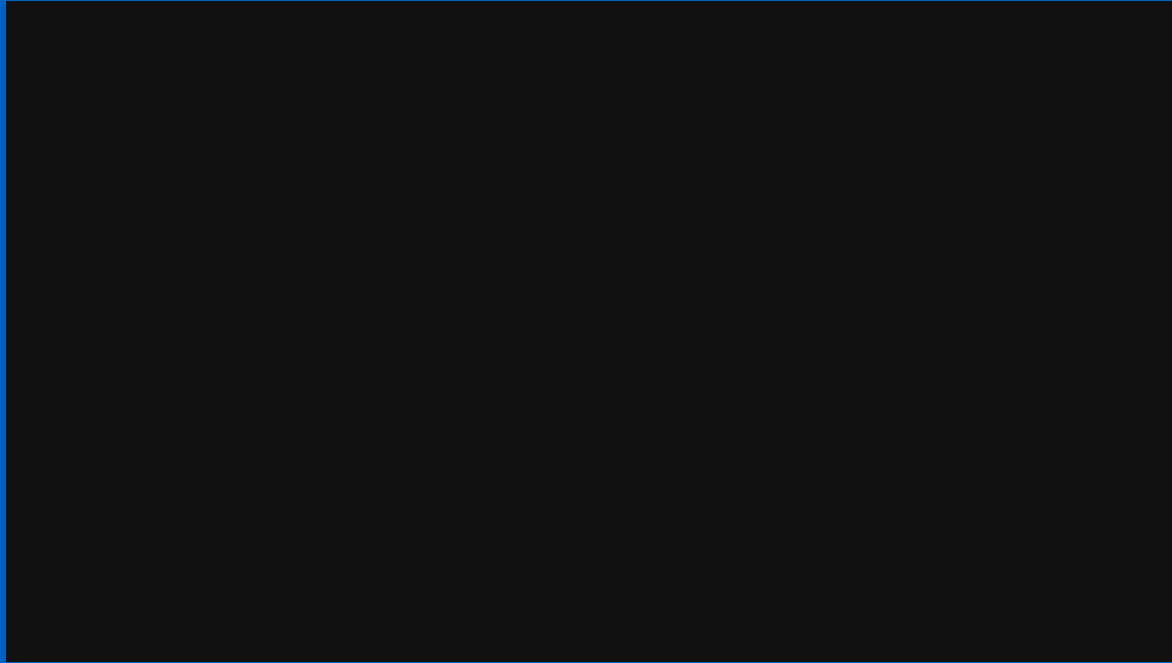

## Introducing Double PAC Match!

- All PAC contributions made at the Double-Helix level will be matched \$2-for-\$1
- Double-Helix levels – calculated on base salary only:
  - 0.5 of 1.0% for levels 6 and below
  - 1.0% for levels 7 and 8
  - 1.5% for levels 9 and above
- All non-Double-Helix members will still receive the \$1-for-\$1 PAC Match benefit
