

Minimum Requirements


INROADS application verifies you:

- 1. Are a Full-Time <u>UNDERGRADUATE</u> seeking 1st Bachelors Degree
 - > Enrolled at four-year accredited college/university
 - Community College candidates must intend to transfer to traditional four-year
- 2. Have an overall cumulative GPA of a 2.8+
- 1. Have at least one open summer before you graduate college
 - Cannot graduate before the Fall following the Summer you intend to intern
- 2. Are available full-time during the summer for at least 8-12 consecutive weeks






UNITED STATES FOOTPRINT



INROADS is proud of its scope and accomplishments:


- Train and place approximately 1,300 students each year into paid internships

- Provide intensive leadership development training and support to our interns, including Leadership Development Institute for graduating seniors as well as summer Intern Development Days that are held in 8 geographic markets across the U.S.
- Graduated more than 28,000 leaders in its history, achieving unparalleled success in securing job offers.
- Among 2018 INROADS graduates, 88% have accepted positions offered by their sponsoring companies, and 74% entered fulltime positions upon graduating.


Significant Disparity of Interns: By Race-Ethnicity
